Directions to KSE

Kirkby Stephen is a market town in the Cumbrian Pennines. Routes included the **A66** accessed via **Scotch Corner (A1)** to the East or **(M6) Penrith** to the West or from **Tebay** along the **A685**

A66 route: turn off at A685 marked Brough/Kirkby Stephen. Drive through the town and we are immediately after the Croglin Castle Pub on the right.

Tebay route: follow A685 past Kirkby Stephen West Station (Settle and Carlisle Line) and turn left just after the bridge before the Croglin Castle Pub

Volunteers are at KSE most weekends and visitors are always welcome.

Kirkby Stephen East Station (KSE) first opened in 1862 as Kirkby Stephen Station on the **South Durham and Lancashire Union Railway** and was the principle station between Darlington and Tebay.

KSE linked the historic **Stainmore and Eden Valley Lines** and closed to passenger traffic in 1962.

The near derelict building was purchased by Stainmore Properties Limited (SPL) in 1996.

A group of volunteers began restoration work on the site with a vision to create a **Railway Heritage Centre / operational railway** and this group became **Stainmore Railway Company (SRC)**

Stainmore Railway Company

SRC's vision is steadily becoming reality and we have negotiated a long term lease with SPL. We aim to run both **steam and diesel** trains using restored **LNER Gresley Teak Coaches** and other representative stock that ran on the line.

Stock and Work at KSE

Members of SRC own a wide range of stock including two steam locomotives:

0-4-0 saddle-tank 2084 (Peckett and Sons, Bristol 1948) and **J94 0-6-0 8009**. Main-line diesels on the site include **Class 20 169**, **Class 31 410**, two **Class 37s** and **Class 47 785**. There are **two industrial diesels** on the site Hibberd Planet and Yorkshire Engine in addition to a two car DMU. Other stock includes six **Gresley Coaches**, a NER brake van and a works train.



SRC have restored a number of rooms in the station and there is small **museum** on the site

in addition to an education room, **shop**, **buffet car** (seasonal for light refreshments), **picnic area** and ample **free car parking**. Admission is free but on events day charges may apply (see website for details).

We are working closely with **Eden District Council**, **local schools** and **community groups** to develop the site and the line.
